Kentish Town station, located in the London Borough of Camden at the junction of Kentish Town Road (A400) and Leighton Road, serves as an interchange for both London Underground and National Rail services. It lies within Travelcard Zone 2.

The Underground station is situated on the High Barnet branch of the Northern line, while the National Rail station is served by Thameslink trains operating on the Midland Main Line. Notably, Kentish Town is the only station on the High Barnet branch offering a direct interchange with National Rail services.

Description:

The subject unit is situated next to the entrance of Kentish Town Underground Station. The property spans the basement, ground, and first floors. The front entrance is secured by a roller shutter which then leads to a glass door.
