West Kensington Underground Stations is situated on the District Line within zone 2 of the Transport for London network between Barons Court and Earls Court Underground Stations and benefits from 3.7 million passengers per year. The Station sits on the junction of the North End Road (B317) and West Cromwell Road (A4) which links directly into central London.

West Kensington Station is within the London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham which has strong domestic and commuter population. In addition to this the stations acts as a key transport connection for local attractions such as the Olympia Exhibition Centre and The Queen's Club.
