

Acton Town is a London Underground station located in the south-west of Acton, within the London Borough of Ealing. The station serves the District and Piccadilly lines. On the district line, Acton Town lies between Chiswick Park and Ealing Common stations. On the Piccadilly line, it is situated between Hammersmith and Ealing Common, with Turnham Green additionally served during early mornings and late evenings. The Unit is positioned at the junction of Gunnersbury Lane and Bollo Lane.


